The 5 Steps to Data Collection

Step 1: Clarify your data collection goals

This sounds straight forward enough, but it is often overlooked. For example, what problem are you trying to solve by collecting this data? Be sure to be clear about your purpose for data collection.

Step 2: Develop operational definitions and procedures

What are we measuring? How will it be measured? Who will measure it? Having clarity in these questions is of utmost importance. Often times we will employ sampling in which case we need to define a sampling plan.

Step 3: Validate the measurement system

Confirm your measurement system by doing a test run before the actual data collection stragegy is implemented. Try to insure that all persons collecting data are following the same measurement system.

Step 4: Begin data collection

Using all the knowledge from the previous steps, we now go off and collect our data.

Step 5: Continue improving measurement system and ensure people are following the data collection guidelines

Measurement systems need to be verified often. Also, as with anything related to continuous improvement, sustaining a process is the hardest part. Data collection is no different.
